

**A hand from the France-Slovenia match in 1993**

Michel Lebel took opportunity of a slight error in defence for a spectacular play on the following board :

The lead was the 4 of Diamond to East's queen .East feared – wrongly- that South could hold the Jack of diamond and return a heart to Queen and King .West played back a Diamond .South took the third round of Diamond with the Ace but choose to discard the Ace of Hearts from hand. It can be seen that these two red Aces on the table at the same trick were the right choice for the declarer
